Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace and peace to you on this Pentecost Sunday!

I am writing regarding the care and support of our retired diocesan priests. As you may know, there are 163 diocesan priests faithfully serving Jesus Christ and our diocesan Church. Of these, 15 priests are retired currently, and over the next ten years 17 additional priests will reach retirement age.

To provide care for our current and future retired priests, the annual second collection for retired priests will take place next weekend, **June 2nd and 3rd**, at all Masses. I ask you to consider participating as generously as you are able in next week's collection.

The funds from this annual collection will assist the ongoing operational needs and expenses of the *Saint Rose of Lima Priests Retirement Villa*, a residence designed to accommodate retired diocesan priests. This beautiful and restful home, which opened in 2010, includes both common areas and private residences for up to eight priests. Additionally, this second collection will provide funds for post-retirement health care, nursing home care, and the priest pension fund.

May the Risen Lord Jesus abundantly reward your goodness and fill you and those you love with His peace, hope and life!
