Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace and peace to you on this Solemnity of the Ascension of our Lord!

I am writing regarding our second collection next weekend (May 18-19, 2013), which will benefit our retired diocesan priests. This collection, held annually, helps to care for our current and future retired priests. It is vital that we pray and support our priests who have dedicated their lives to serving God's people. Our priests work tirelessly to bring the presence of Christ to the faithful.

As you may know, there are 164 diocesan priests faithfully serving Jesus Christ and our diocesan Church. Of these, 17 priests are retired currently, and over the next ten years, 17 additional priests will reach retirement age. Retired priests may choose to live on their own, with family or friends, at a parish rectory, or at the *Saint Rose of Lima Priests Retirement Villa*. This Villa, which opened in 2010, is a beautiful and restful home and includes both common areas and private residences for up to eight priests with provisions in the future for twenty retired priests.

The funds from this annual collection will assist the ongoing operational needs and expenses of the *Saint Rose of Lima Priests Retirement Villa*. Additionally, this second collection will provide funds for post-retirement health care, nursing home care, or the priest pension fund. I ask you to consider prayerfully participating in next week's second collection to benefit our beloved priests who serve Christ and our Diocesan Church so faithfully.
