I founded Immaculata Movement and published a magazine titled “The Knight of Immaculata”. To build awareness of my Movement I traveled around the world, specifically to Japan and India. I returned home when I got sick and during WWII was arrested by the Nazis. I was sent to the concentration camp at Auschwitz (one of the deadliest camps). It was during my time here that a prisoner escaped so 10 men were chosen to die as a consequence. I volunteered to take the place of a young husband and father who was chosen to die. Because of my actions, I am a martyr. Who am I?
