My feast day is August 14th. I was born in Poland and when I was old enough I studied theology and became a priest. I founded Immaculata Movement and published a magazine titled “The Knight of Immaculata”. To build awareness of my Movement I traveled around the world, specifically to Japan and India. I returned home when I got sick and during WWII was arrested by the Nazis. I was sent to the concentration camp at Auschwitz (one of the deadliest camps). It was during my time here that a prisoner escaped so 10 men were chosen to die as a consequence. I volunteered to take the place of a young husband and father who was chosen to die. Because of my actions, I am a martyr. Who and I?

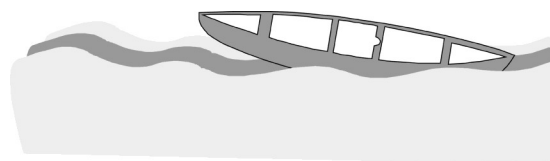

Volunteers Needed for the Guadalupe Free Clinic (GFC)

The GFC of Colonial Beach is a medical free clinic serving the indigent and medically-uninsured population of Westmoreland County, southeast of Fredericksburg. Founded in 2004, by Fr. Jerome Magat, the GFC is a part of the Catholic Diocese of Arlington and operates on the grounds of St. Elizabeth of Hungary Catholic Church in Colonial Beach, and is mainly staffed by volunteers. The clinic is seeking volunteers for all our medical and non-medical positions. This includes Doctors, Nurses, Phlebotomists, Pharmacists, PharmTechs, Spanish Interpreters, Receptionists, and Eligibility Coordinators. The clinic's most immediate volunteer needs are for Pharmacists and Interpreters. The clinic is only open on Wednesdays and Saturdays, so our volunteers normally work once a month.
