Religious Education

Name the Saint!

My feast day is July 18th. I was born in Naples, Italy. My father was away serving in the military so it was just my mother and I. I had my father's temper which my mother did not know how to control and after she died I was sent to live with extended family members who treated me badly. At age 16 I left to join my father in the military and spent many years fighting alongside him on the battlefield. When my regiment disbanded I went to work as a laborer for a monastery. It was there that I found my religious calling. Because of a leg wound I received on the battlefield I was denied entrance into religious formation the first time, but after spending time with my mentor Philip Neri (also a saint) and discovering my love for ministering to the sick in the hospitals, I tried again and was accepted. Once becoming a priest I founded the Ministers of the Infirm (also known popularly as the Camillians). We helped soldiers on the battlefield and our symbol was a red cross which is still used today as a sign of charity and service. I am patron saint of the sick, hospital, and those who care for the ill. Who am I?

The USCCB supports earned legalization

Week 7 of 8 from Bishop Burbidge

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops supports an earned legalization program that would allow foreign nationals of good moral character who are living in the United States to apply to adjust their status to obtain lawful permanent residence. Such a program would create an eventual path to citizenship, requiring applicants to complete and pass background checks, pay a fine, and establish eligibility for resident status to participate in the program.
