Dress Code

This code is what is expected of all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Readers, Ushers and Cantors.

It is inappropriate to wear items that draw attention to one's self (i.e., inappropriate pictures, drawings, words, sayings, or color combinations.)

Men are expected to wear:

```
Dress Pants, Shirt and Tie with Sports Coat*
or
Business Suit*, Shirt and Tie
and
Dress Shoes (No sandals or flip-flops)
```

*Do not wear a Sweater or Uniform of any kind to replace a Sports Coat or Suit.

Women must <u>not</u> wear clothing with hemlines above the knee, low necklines, are tight or form-fitting and are not to wear slacks, pantsuits, or uniforms of any kind.

Women are expected to wear:

```
Dress with Sleeves
or
Skirt and Blouse with Sleeves
or
Business Suit with Blouse
and
Dress Shoes (No stilettos, sandals or designer flip-flops)
```
